You are being asked to take part in this study because you care for patients with differences of sex development (DSD). If you choose to be in the study, you will complete a survey which will help us learn more about gonadectomy and gonadal tissue cryopreservation practices. The survey will take about 15 minutes to complete.

Being in this study is optional and voluntary. You do not have to take this survey if you do not want to. The answers that you provide in the survey may still be used if you stop the survey and do not finish. The survey will ask you for information that can identify you. The identifiable information that will be collected is your email address and institution where you practice. The investigators need to collect this information to ensure unique survey responses as well as to aggregate regional trends in gonadal care and management including gonadectomy and gonadal tissue cryopreservation practices. This survey will be done online using the service Qualtrics. Information provided in this survey can only be kept as secure as any other online communication.

There are no direct benefits to you for taking this survey. The information learned from this survey will help the researchers learn more about practice patterns amongst providers caring for patients with DSD.
