- Deadline to receive program committee decision (via email): August 31, 2024

Please make sure to include the following items in your abstract document:

- Title: Provide a title of less than 150 characters, including spaces.
- Author(s): Provide the name, email address & affiliation of each author. Please highlight the presenting author who should register and attend the conference in person.
- Body: Submit a structured abstract of 150 to 300 words divided into the following 4 sections: Purpose, Methods, Results & Conclusion.
- Keywords: Provide 4 to 6 keywords
- Financial Support: List any organizations, grants, or individuals funding your research.
- Conflict of Interest if any.

Note to Winners of Abstract Awards:

Four abstracts will be selected for the oral award presentation. All other accepted abstracts will be considered for a poster presentation. The presenting author of oral or poster presentations should register and attend the conference in person.
